Thank you to everyone who has participated in the South District UWF activities in person or via live stream. Seeing our district grow is reassuring, and we aim to continue this trend in the coming years.



Diane Vogan, Registrar, significantly reported registration/attendance at each listed event. Starting with the **Mission Study** at Foothills UMC in La Mesa, CA, on March 16th, with 45 participants in attendance; the **Spiritual Growth Retreat** at First United Methodist Church of San Diego, on May 18th, with 24 participants in attendance; the **2024 Quiet Day** Apart on June 8th at Community United Methodist Church in Huntington Beach, CA, with 61 participants in attendance and my report of the **California Pacific Conference Mission u** on July 12-14 at California State University, Long Beach with eighteen (18) participants in attendance at the South District called meeting at Mission u.

Do I need to say more?! Ladies, we are back and going strong; let's continue to increase the number of in-person and live-streaming participants in 2025 and beyond!

The Essence of Leadership

You need more than talent and a title to be worthy of a following. The essence of leadership lies in doing two things. *(1) Going first!* "Cross over ahead of your fellow Israelites." If God has called you to lead, you must step out in faith and go first. That requires believing in yourself and your mission. Accomplishment requires more than just working hard; it requires believing the right thing. God told Joshua, "Be strong and courageous. And in case you're wondering, "How long do I have to keep investing in this person?" the answer is until "they also...take possession of the land that God---is giving them." Many people will serve when compelled to, and some will serve in a crisis. But when you have a servant's heart, you initiate service to others. Knowing God will

reward you; you see the need, seize the opportunity, and serve. Therefore, you serve with gladness. So here is the deal: you only qualify to enjoy the privileges of leadership when you're willing to go first and then take others with you. But that's not the end of the story. God said, "After that, you may go back and occupy your land, which...the Lord gave you." So, remember your *special calling to walk boldly in our faith and our mission to inspire, influence, and impact local and global communities with our vision* of supporting women, children, and youth.

TREASURER'S NOTES

Dear United Women in Faith sisters,



I'm pulling myself away from the summer Olympics in Paris as I write. What a remarkable and unifying event of committed people from around the world! In a like manner, UWF is a unifying force of committed women who affect people in many countries around the world. Our Christian value of inclusiveness is echoed in the now greater inclusiveness in athletics. UWF's unifying efforts, of course, are directed in part to "expand concepts of mission through participation in the global ministries of the church." And we've been doing this for more than 150 years, which is longer than the modern Olympics have been happening.

Our South District of Cal-Pac Conference has an ambitious goal of \$75,000 in Mission Giving for 2024. At the end of July we have reached nearly \$36,000 in Mission Giving, 48% of our goal.

Continue the good work and encourage members in giving. Check out the National office program of Move 4 Mission fundraisers. Visit uwfaith.org/move4mission for ideas and to learn more.

Blind from a childhood illness, she became a musical prodigy, writing songs (or dictating the lyrics), one of which I heard on an old recording and asked my music director if we could present it to the congregation. Imagine my surprise to learn who the author was! None other than Miss Fanny Crosby!


If you want to find Reading Program books without buying them, consider looking for them at the public library. The San Diego City Library has 11 of the 21 books in the 2024 Education for Mission Category and 11 of the 16 books for 2024 category of Social Action. I haven't had a chance to check the other categories. There are over 100 copies of the Education for Mission book *They Called Us Enemy* by George Takei. There are many copies of the Social Action books *Saving Us: A Climate Scientist's Case for Hope and Healing in a Divided World* by Katherine Hayhoe, and *The Sum of Us: What Racism Costs Everyone* by Heather McGhee. Which ever library you use, it can probably get you these popular books.

Social Action - Reduce Gun Violence

Reducing gun violence is not a political issue. It is a public health and safety issue. We all have a right to safety. The data is undeniable that gun violence is the leading cause of death of children and teens. A mandatory firearm purchase waiting period **saves lives**. Banning assault weapons **saves lives**. A universal background check **saves lives**. When it comes to gun violence, **we know how we can save lives**. 85% of all Americans support many of these common-sense measures. Thoughts and prayers won't stop gun violence. Weak politicians won't either. We must **vote them out**.

Supporting the Right to Safety Constitutional Amendment would enshrine fundamental, broadly supported gun safety measures into the bedrock of our nation's laws, including:

- Raising the minimum age to buy a gun from 18 to 21
- Mandating universal background checks
- Instituting a waiting period for all gun purchases
- Banning the sale of assault weapons and other weapons of war to civilians

The Right to Safety Amendment preserves the 2nd Amendment while also securing common-sense gun laws that our communities want and desperately need.



New Entra Casa was established by the Wesleyan Service Guild to meet the needs of formerly incarcerated women. In recent years the program has become a medical provider for women dealing with substance abuse. The average stay at the home is 90 days but varies due to individual needs. Women are often reunited with their families.

There is no fee to the women to participate in the program. Much of the operating budget is funded by the county contract, but not totally, so all donations are needed and appreciated.

Our next fundraiser will be held on Sunday, November 10th at 2:00 at St. Paul United Methodist Church, located at 3094 L Street in San Diego. Gift baskets will be available through a silent auction.
