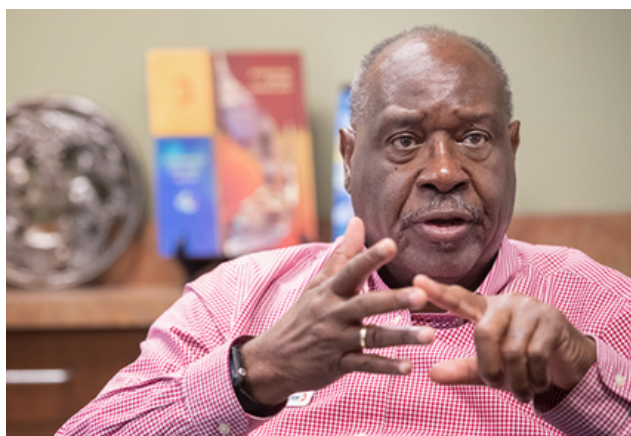
Bishops Serving UMM & NACP

Mark Dehority, Pres., Ken Hudgins, VP, Don Davis, Sec., Robert Wright and Larry Dozier, Co-Treasurers.

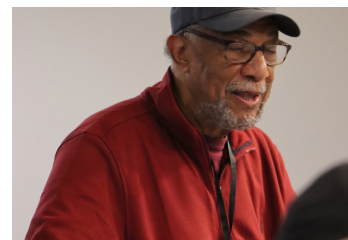
UMM Foundation - Supporting GCUMM

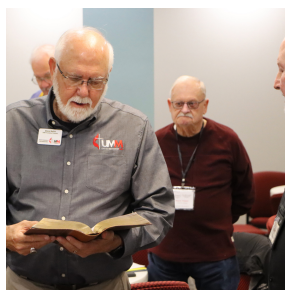


NACP Prayer Advocate

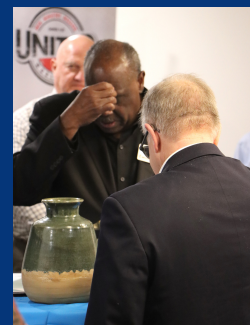


DIRECTOR SCOUTING MINISTRY
